## SUMMER HOURS

## FEES

Camp fees include all field trip fees and admissions, bus transportation, activity supplies and lots of fun. A sack lunch is required from home everyday.  
\$20 registration fee plus:  
Resident – \$110.00 per week  
Non-resident - \$120.00 per week

## GUIDELINES FOR CAMP REGISTRATION & SIGN UP

Emergency Forms – Emergency Forms must be completed and on file before any child attends camp.

Registration – Registration for all camps will be accepted at the Fon du Lac Park District Administration Center only. Camp Connect 4 Fun runs on a weekly basis.

Residency – Resident rates apply to everyone who lives in Fon du Lac Park District boundaries. Non-resident fees are the second fees shown. You may be asked to show proof of residency.

Payment – Payment can be made by walk in or by calling using a credit card. Your child is not registered until payment is made and all necessary paper work is filled out.

Space Availability – Each camp has a minimum and maximum of how many campers we take. Camps do fill up fast. If an insufficient number of registrations have been taken in a program, the Park District will issue a full refund.

Refunds – A 90% refund of camp fees will be granted if the refund request is received at least 7 business days prior to the start of the camp session. No refund will be allowed after that date. Missed days may not be applied to future week.

Subsidy Participants – An approval letter is required at the time of registration.
