We want your child's experience with us to be a rewarding one. In our program, your child will continue to develop his/her social skills such as sharing, taking turns, standing in line, and being respectful of others.

## CLASS TIMES - FEES - REQUIREMENTS:

Class Meets: Morning Class 9:00 - 11:30am  
5 days a week (Monday - Friday)

Monthly Fees: \$135

Max Class Size: 20 children

First Day of Class: Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>

Age Requirement: Child must be 3 years old as of September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024

***Children must be potty trained and be able to take care of his/her bathroom needs.***

- ◆ Monthly payments are due at the **beginning** of each month.
- ◆ There is a one-time \$25.00 material fee due when you register your child.
- ◆ Fees are based on the full school year – number of class dates does vary month to month.
- ◆ We accept Cash – Checks (make payable to Fon du Lac Park District) - VISA/MC/DISCOVER.

## REGISTRATION:

Fill out the attached Registration Form and return to Fon du Lac Park District Administration Center with \$25 material fee.

## DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP YOUR CHILD:

The classroom will open **five minutes prior to class**. Please use the main entrance to the Park District Administration Center. Please do not bring your child too early. The teachers need this time to prepare for class.

To pick up your child, please line up outside the Rainbow Room's outside door and we will bring your child out at 11:30am.

## PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD:

Please provide us with names and phone numbers of persons authorized to pick up your child on the registration form. If someone other than an authorized person will be picking up your child, please notify us in writing, stating the person's name, relationship to your child, and a phone number.

## VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS:

Our room as well as the Administration Center is equipped with cameras for added security.

## NOT ATTENDING CLASS:

Call 699-4813 to tell us your child will not be attending class for any reason. Please do not send your child if he/she has had a fever, diarrhea, or has vomited in the last 24 hours prior to class. We would also like to know what the illness is when your child is sick.



## **MEDICATION:**

If your child is on medication, please indicate so on the registration form. Also, let us know if there are medication changes throughout the school year.

## **OTHER INFORMATION:**

Special treats are allowed for birthdays and/or special occasions. These treats must be store bought items.

We use a behavior chart as well as “Time-Out” for discipline reasons. If your child’s behavior becomes a concern, our teachers will talk with you about the situation as it becomes apparent.

A book bag is helpful for your child to bring items to class and take-home arts and crafts. Please mark your child’s name on all belongings that are brought to class. There are often other children that have similar items.
